# Happy Epiphany!

It's a snowy day in December as I write this. And yet, even as I prepare for the coming of Christmas, I'm also looking forward to Epiphany! Epiphany means "appearance," or "manifestation." In literary terms, an epiphany is an "ah ha!" moment in which a new realization, a new light is shone on the story. The new light becomes the prism through which everything else is made clear.

That's what "Epiphany" is about – it is our "ah ha" – the light shining in our lives, the Christ light that is the prism through which we see our lives. In the dark days of December and January, we yearn for those days that the sun shines brightly – even if it means that it is colder. We can always bundle up – but we need the sun, we need the light.

# CHERISH ALL CHILDREN EMPOWERING PARENTS & YOUTH TO PREVENT CHILD SEXUAL EXPLOITATION AND TRAFFICKING

Sunday, January 5th—Adult & Youth Forum How can we come together to raise healthy generations free from sexual exploitation? Sunday, January 5th, we will hear how each one of us can make a difference to protect children and youth. Joy McElroy, Executive Director of Cherish All Children will share how our Mission of the Month gifts are put to work directly with Confirmation and Youth Groups in our churches.

Joy will share new tools being used with youth, including discussions about online safety with social media and gaming, vulnerabilities, and safety planning with healthy adults in their lives. An introduction to the 5 session youth training "Not a Number" will also show how youth can be empowered to make safe choices and understand healthy vs. unhealthy relationships. We hope you will join us!

### SEEING 2020: FOCUS ON THE FUTURE

Seeing 20/20 is our theme for 2020. As we begin a new decade, we will first look back at the ministry we have done over the past year, ten years and 76 years. And we will give thanks for the work that God has done in, with and through the people of Faith-Lilac Way. But then, we can ask: where is God at work in our community of faith and the community outside our walls today? And how do we think that we can be a part of what God is doing in the future?

As we focus on the future, we believe that working together gives energy and vision for the mission we share. Other churches have found that a Community Organizer helps them reach out more intentionally to the neighborhood. But we are the first collection of churches that has sought to do this together. This is something new. Certainly, there are risks and challenges. Hiring a person together requires a leap of faith as well as your love, prayers and support. But, together, we believe we can make this vision a reality. And that's exciting.



# JANUARY MISSION OF THE MONTH: CHERISH ALL CHILDREN



Cherish All Children, our mission of the Month for January, is an ELCA ministry that equips congregations to prevent child sexual exploitation. The heart of this ministry lies in

congregations, where staff, leaders, and members pray, educate, connect with others, and act on behalf of children within and outside their congregations. It begins with prayer. On **January 12** we as a congregation will renew our pledge to pray for all children and youth ages 1 day to 25 years old. We believe that prayer makes a difference for children. Prayer is the beginning but preventing child sexual exploitation requires a multifaceted effort to raise awareness as well as change attitudes and behaviors. Cherish All Children also works with

churches to educate youth, parents, and other congregation members about sexual exploitation, prevention, and social media safety. Cherish All Children helps Connect churches with other networks or organizations that work to prevent child sexual exploitation so that we can partner with their work. This sends a message to the community that the church takes seriously its role as a protector of children. Finally, Cherish All Children promotes action both inside and outside of the church walls. Churches can get involved in updating their own safe church policies, advocating for legislation, organizing a service project for victims or letter-writing campaigns to stop advertisements or corporate practices that sexually exploit children. If you don't have a child to pray for, contact the office or Sue Ferkingstad, our Cherish All Children liaison.
