I'm fickle about snow. In the early days of winter I love the snow sparkling in the sunlight and hanging from the treetops. It's beautiful! And yet, I'm more than ready for it to melt – even though it is only March and we could, realistically, get even more. But right now, I'm looking forward to spring and warm weather and don't want to see another snowflake ... until next year when I will once again yearn for the beautiful flakes to cover the barren trees and ground.

I look forward and even anticipate the changing of the seasons of the church year too. Lent is a wonderful time for soup suppers and midweek services. It is a time for focusing on faith. But the season of Lent is coming to a close in April just as Spring is coming (eventually). The name Lent even anticipates the change in season since it comes from the Middle English word "lente" which means springtime.

This season leads into Holy Week. You know the story – and yet, it is important for us to hear it again, each year, just as the Israelites promised to remember and tell the story of the Passover each year. Telling the story, singing the songs, and proclaiming Christ's death for you and for me reminds each of us of the great gift of the love of God. We are reminded that Christ died – not just for the people of Israel – but for each one of us.

On Easter morning we hear the unbelievable – if not for the gift of faith – story of Jesus' resurrection from the dead and the promise of new life for us all. If we can stand, for a moment, in Mary Magdalene's shoes, we will be filled with fear and awe and at the same time overwhelmed with joy. For we learn, again, of God's great love. God's love is not fickle. God's love is everlasting.

You are invited and I hope that you will join us in person if you can – or online or via mailed bulletins – as we tell the story of Jesus' passion and resurrection during Holy week and Easter worship. You know the story. But it is a story that never grows old. Instead, we discover new life in Christ as we sing our Alleluias and rejoice in the wonder of God's love.

Calling All Animals and Pet Lovers! Join us for Blessing of the Animals on Sunday, April 16th!


All God's critters have a place in the choir–some sing low, some sing high and some sing out loud sitting on the telephone wire, and some just clap their hands or paws or anything they've got now!


