
Mission of the Month: NEAR FOODSHELF School Supplies

School supplies will be accepted between July 15th and August 15th for distribution between

August 23rd and September 3rd. We welcome all supplies, but we especially need backpacks, 2" and 3" 3-ring binders with dividers, loose-leaf paper (both wide and college ruled), spiral notebooks (both wide and college ruled), composition books, colored pencils, pencil pouches and pencil boxes. We can get sturdy backpacks deeply discounted, so, if wanted, a person could donate \$25 to cover the entire cost of school supplies for one child. Depending on the grade, this would include a backpack, pencils, a pencil sharpener, erasers, pens, loose-leaf paper, spiral notebooks, composition books, glue sticks, glue, scissors, crayons, markers, highlighters, a 3-ring binder, binder divider pages, folders, and a pencil pouch/box. Some people like to shop, others like to have the convenience of a donation; we are happy to use whatever is more convenient for you. As always, we are incredibly grateful for all you do to make NEAR a success. School supplies will be distributed 8/23/21 to 9/03/21.
